Professional organizations affiliated with the OPEIU are a diverse group which includes physicians, optometrists, pharmacists, chiropractors, appraisers, podiatrists, clinical social workers, biofeedback practitioners, acupuncturists, hypnotists and helicopter pilots. Partnering with the OPEIU benefits them in a number of ways. Affiliation with the OPEIU has given these groups more legislative clout and greater access to people who need their services.

With Healthcare becoming an increasing concern and national issue, any national healthcare plan should be represented with a strong voice for acupuncture services. The Guild and it affiliations is the only organization poised to add this greater bargaining message to the collective table.
